



Giffords' first bill aims to bar sale of F-14 parts

An effort to bar the Pentagon from selling surplus parts for the F-14 fighter jet - a plane now flown only by Iran - will be the first bill introduced by U.S. Rep. Gabrielle Giffords, D-Ariz.

Giffords sits on the House Armed Services Committee.

"I don't believe most Americans are aware of the fact that the Iranians do have a fleet of F-14s and that we sold them to them," Giffords said.

Her bill is similar to a Senate bill that would permanently ban the Defense Department from selling surplus F-14 parts.
